Electrical

- ☐ Digital multimeter
- ☐ Assorted blade fuses
- ☐ Fuse puller
- ☐ Crimping tool
- ☐ Wire strippers
- ☐ Butt / ring / spade connectors
- ☐ Electrical tape
- ☐ Small roll of wire
- ☐ Spare self-resetting breakers (if used)
- ☐ Flashlight or headlamp

Plumbing

- ☐ PEX / Flair-It / Sea Tech fittings that match your RV
- ☐ Short repair length of fresh water tubing
- ☐ Tubing cutter
- ☐ Leak repair tape
- ☐ Spare water pump strainer
- ☐ Spare rubber washers
- ☐ Teflon tape
- ☐ Adjustable wrench
- ☐ Paper towels or shop rags

Roof & Sealant

- ☐ Self-leveling RV lap sealant
- ☐ Non-sag RV sealant
- ☐ RV roof repair tape
- ☐ Disposable gloves
- ☐ Plastic scraper
- ☐ Rags or shop towels
- ☐ Small caulking gun

Sewer

- ☐ Spare sewer cap
- ☐ Twist-on waste valve
- ☐ Spare sewer hose gasket
- ☐ Spare bayonet fitting
- ☐ Clear sewer adapter
- ☐ Disposable gloves
- ☐ Keep sewer items separate

Propane

- ☐ Propane leak detector solution
- ☐ Proper-size wrench for fittings
- ☐ Spare propane pigtail (if appropriate)
- ☐ Know where propane shutoff valves are

Fasteners & Temporary Fixes

- ☐ Assorted zip ties
- ☐ Assorted screws
- ☐ Hose clamps
- ☐ Bungee cords
- ☐ Utility knife
- ☐ Screwdriver set
- ☐ Pliers
- ☐ Work gloves
- ☐ Duct tape or repair tape
- ☐ Small parts organizer

Leave This at Home

- ☐ Random parts that do not fit your RV
- ☐ Heavy tools you never use
- ☐ Wrong sealants
- ☐ Unknown electrical parts
- ☐ Plumbing fittings that do not match your system
- ☐ Propane parts you are not comfortable installing



Quick Safety Reminders

Use the right sealant for the job. Never guess with propane.
Build your kit around your RV, not someone else's.
